Please remember that mosquito season is upon us. To avoid mosquito-borne illnesses, please check that you do not have any standing water outside your home. Please note that the new recycling bins from Rumpke can hold water if the lid is not properly closed, so please drain out any standing water as soon as you notice it.

Elm trees throughout the Village and surrounding areas are dying out due to disease and insect infestation. If you have an elm tree on your property, please watch for this. In short term, or the next year or two, you could very well need to arrange to have the tree removed to avoid a life/safety issue with falling large branches.

If you have brush to remove from your property, the Maintenance Department is still taking requests for a dump truck to be placed on the street in front of your proeprty so that you can load up the back with brush. The Maintenance Department will haul it away at no charge. Please contact Joe Huskey at the number above to make arrangements.
