Light Ohio Blue – Week of May 8 to May 16

The Village of Fairfax has joined the Light Ohio Blue campaign to show and generate support for law enforcement personnel who protect our communities throughout our great state.

In 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a proclamation which designated May 15 as Peace Officers Memorial Day and the week in which that date falls as Police Week. The Light Ohio Blue campaign coincides with activities associated to Police Week. This year's dates are Wednesday May 8 to Thursday May 16.

Residents in Fairfax are encouraged to show their support for law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty and those currently serving, both sworn and civilian staff.

How can you help? The Fairfax Police Department will have blue lights available starting May 1st. We ask that you replace your porch light with a blue light bulb during the week of May 8 to May 16. We will also have blue ribbon available. On Police Memorial Day – May 15, we encourage you to wear blue.

Fairfax Recycled 115 Tons in 2018

Congratulations, Fairfax residents! In 2018, we recycled 115.33 tons of metal, glass, plastic, and paper. Residents saved resources, conserved energy, and reduced pollution by not sending these items to the landfill.

The recycling efforts in Fairfax: • Conserved enough energy to power every home in Fairfax for 9 days. • Reduced more air pollution than if every household in Fairfax rode their bicycle to work for 6 weeks. • Saved 999 trees from being harvested.

On average, each household in Fairfax recycled 275 pounds in 2018. That's 13.38% of all the waste we generate.

SCAMMER ALERT



Today, scammers are more prevalent than ever and will say and do anything to steal your money. Recently, the number one way for a scammer to get to your money is by the use of gift cards. If someone calls you with urgent news or a convincing story and then pressures you to pay them by buying a gift card like iTunes, Google Play card, etc. and then giving them the codes off the back of the card – **STOP!! – IT IS A SCAM!**

Gift cards are the number one payment method that imposters demand. They may pose as an IRS official, Law Enforcement Officer, family member with an emergency, public works employee, or a service members asking for donations. Scammers may even call you with great news that you won a contest. These people know how to play into your fears, hopes and sympathies. They like to use gift cards because once they have the code on the back, the money is gone and it is almost impossible to trace. Knowing about these scams can help prevent them, so please share this information with your friends and loved ones. If you paid a scammer with gift cards, call the card company and let them know the cards were used in a scam.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT GIFT CARDS ARE NEVER ASKED TO BE USED AS A LEGITIMATE FORM OF PAYMENT.
